II. Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to

- A. have a significant component of the program of the SDSU in a complementary nature of the institutions
- B. provide inter-college education for students of both institutions
- C. extend and clarify educational opportunities for students
- D. provide NCTA students who have completed the A.S. degree in Agricultural Education, Communication, and Leadership Specialization.

III. Academic

- A. Upon successful completion of the requirements specified below, SDSU will accept 60 course credits from the A.S. degree in Agricultural Education for students majoring in SDSU's Agricultural Education, Communication, and Leadership Specialization. Students must successfully complete the Agricultural Education from NCTA prior to transferring to SDSU. Students must meet all South Dakota Board of Regents requirements in order to receive credit.
- B. Requirements to be met by SDSU students majoring in Agricultural Education, Communication, and Leadership Specialization are outlined below.
