The Accelerated Option is for Students who have completed a Baccalaureate degree in any field and wish to obtain a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree. The program is completed in 12 months and begins once a year (August) in Sioux Falls and once a year (January) in Aberdeen. To be considered for admissions, students must have a pre-nursing GPA* of 3.0 or higher and a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher. The College of Nursing also requires a n. Meeting minimum qualifications does not guarantee acceptance into the Nursing

major. Students are selected competitively based on experiences, attributes, and metrics. Admission criteria may include academic score, personal statements, personal references, and an interview with the admissions committee.

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
